

Parking Privileges Request Form **2018 - 2019** school year

How the “Parking Privileges” Relationship Works:

Parking privileges at *Hope* is a relationship not a business.

We ask that parkers cooperate in *Hope*'s mission either through volunteering efforts or financial donations.

Parking Privileges are for Monday through Saturday. Parkers are asked to leave by 6pm Saturday night and can return to the lot after 6pm Sunday night. (there is free parking on many UConn lots on weekends)

Cooperation for Special Occasions: There is the possibility in the course of the year that we'll need cooperation from parkers to free up the lot. Parkers might be asked to move their cars temporarily for a funeral, a snow storm... etc. These are infrequent and usually during hours that parking on campus is allowed.

Volunteer Roles:

There is a list of volunteer roles on the “Parking Privileges” page of Hope web site. Please check the status of the roles and call to discuss whether it is a good match for you.

These commitments/responsibilities are an important part of the mission and ongoing life of the church.

Take note of these points:

Winter parking and snow responsibility: We plow the lot ourselves, with volunteers, so realize there might not be immediate access to your car after a big storm. We can plow down the middle while cars are parked and do a thorough cleaning Sat night after storms.

Teamwork is required of parkers. There is not a company that cleans up. It is church volunteers. There are shovels by the front door of the church that you can use to clear the sides of your car and put the snow appropriately off the lot.

Safe driving: No inappropriate driving or disrespectful behavior will be tolerated. You will be asked to not park here anymore.

Parking Pass info: Parkers will be issued a “pass” to hang on the rear view mirror.

Upon starting to park, please introduce yourself, as we like to meet and get to know each parker.

How to Apply: Download the form, read and sign, and mail it or during church office hours.

** Please include checks to Hope Lutheran Church with application if possible.*

Volunteer roles: *If applying for one of the volunteer spots, you must talk with Pastor Nollet to interview for the spot. Use contact info to call/email. (some roles have a \$100 deposit fee that is returned at the end of the semester if responsibilities are carried out)*
